PRESS RELEASE

This press release is a progress update to the press release on 19 April 2016.

Inglett & Stubbs International (ISI) is proud to announce a successful completion of the Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) process conducted on all equipment for the New Luika Power Station Project. All of the equipment has been packaged and shipped from the Netherlands and is in route to the project site in Western Tanzania.



The first assembled and packaged generator was moved out of the factory on Friday 15 July, and relocated to the test facility nearby. A total of 6 packaged generator sets, and the complete Heavy Fuel Oil treatment system was packaged and tested at Intertech in Groot-Ammer, Netherlands. Final testing of all components was completed in early September.

The on-site construction is well underway, the civil and structural foundations are 90% completed and a majority of the electrical and plumbing underground rough-in is completed. The ISI team is preparing to receive the first equipment on-site in early October. The project is on schedule for commissioning and full operations in the first quarter of 2017.



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
